**Ministers at Mass:** *Scheduled bi-weekly. Training provided.*

- Mass Server:** Assist priest at altar. 3rd grade & up.
- Lector:** Proclaim the Word at Liturgies.
- Commentator:** Introduction, General Intercessions & announcements. Open to 3rd grade & up.
- Eucharistic Minister at Weekend Liturgies:** Assists in the distribution of communion at weekend Liturgies. Open to confirmed HS students & adults.
- Eucharistic Minister to the Homebound:** Brings the Eucharist & visits those in their home. Open to confirmed HS students & adults. Great family ministry. Done on Sat afternoons or Sun. mornings.
- Eucharistic Minister or Lector at Funerals:** (circle desired ministry)
- Ministry of Hospitality** (usher/greeter): Greets & seats people, take up collection, pass out materials & handle emergency situations. Open to all ages, individuals or families.
- Sacristan:** Sets up for mass (lighting candles, setting out hosts/wine, etc); cleans up after Mass
- Musician:** Play an instrument to both accompany singers or provide reflection music at Liturgies.
- Choir Member or Cantor:** Lead parish singing
  - Kid's Choir:** for youth in 1st-6th grade
  - Youth Choir:** for youth in 7-12th grade
