OPENING PRAYER

Since the eleventh century, *Veni Sancte Spiritus* (Come Holy Spirit) has been chanted before the Gospel on Pentecost Sunday. The prayer beautifully shows our need for the Holy Spirit in our lives and how helpless we are without him. Let us open our books to page 115 and pray it together.

DIVE IN

Read the “Dive In” aloud to your family.

WATCH IT! SEGMENT 1 (10:04)

FAMILY DISCUSSION (5min)

During discussion spend time as a family answering the questions provided and journaling when prompted. When there is a “Bible Search” find the passage in the Bible, read it aloud and answer the questions that correspond.

- What was the most exciting gift you have ever received?
- What was the most *helpful* gift you ever received? How was it helpful?

FAMILY DISCUSSION (10min)

- What struck you in the video?
- **BIBLE SEARCH** What are the seven Isaiahan Gifts of the Holy Spirit, and what are some examples of how they help us in our daily lives? (hint: Isaiah 11:2-3)
- **JOURNAL** List the Gifts of the Spirit from Isaiah on your paper. What THREE gifts do you see in your life? Circle them... now journal on (1) how you use them and (2) how you can better use them?

WATCH IT! SEGMENT 3 (6:40)

FAMILY DISCUSSION (13min)

- What struck you in the video?
- **BIBLE SEARCH** Name the charismatic Gifts of the Holy Spirit. (hint: 1 Corinthians 12:4-11)
- **JOURNAL** List the charismatic Gifts of the Spirit from 1 Corinthians on your paper. Spend some time journaling about how you could use these gifts in your life.
- **BIBLE SEARCH** Name the Fruits of the Spirit. (hint: Galatians 5:22-23)
- **JOURNAL** List the Fruits of the Spirit from Galatians on your paper. Pick ONE and journal on how you use it in your life then pick ONE that you wish you had more of in your life, and why.
- All segments talked about God's love for each one of us. How do we know God loves us? Why is knowing God's love for us so important? Why do people struggle with this knowledge? How can these gifts and fruits help us with this?

TO THE HEART

Read the "To The Heart" aloud to your family. When done reading journal about and discuss the question below.

- The gifts of the Holy Spirit are a reflection of God's love for us, and we need them more than we can possibly know. What gift would you most like to receive from the Holy Spirit? What gift do you think is *least* common or least used by people?

Have each family member pick ONE challenge at the top of page 4 to complete BEFORE the next class. Have your teen check the box and encourage them to write about it in the space provided. Let them know that you will be sharing these next class to your small group and maybe even the large group.
